Sports Premium Impact Statement 2014-2015

During this year we saw continued success of the use of Sports Premium funding to subsidize our club offer; increasing opportunities for children from all year groups to engage in after school sports. Training has continued for play leaders to support lunchtime activities facilitated by lunchtime supervisors and teaching assistants. Funding has included a wider range of equipment to support the curriculum and competitive sports such as athletics, football, netball, and tennis accessories.

Intra school competition in conjunction with the training of Play Leaders and House Captains takes place at lunchtimes. Opportunities for children to not only participate in sport but organise games and competitions gives ownership of school sport amongst pupils. In addition to the football and netball tournaments organised in the autumn term preparations are underway for inter-school cricket competitions scheduled in the Summer Term.

The majority of the Sports Funding over the year has been spent on ensuring that all children from Year 1 upwards have access to weekly swimming lessons. The impact that this has had on our children is significant. When first starting swimming in Year 1, approximately 17% of children have had any experience of swimming. By the end of the Spring term, approximately 90% of children have developed water confidence and are able to take both feet off the bottom whilst holding on to a float. By the time they leave Year 6, approximately 85% of children can swim confidently.
